## AMPED Vacation Bible School

As a kid growing up with severe ADHD and unlimited amounts of energy, it was hard to understand and stay on board with the whole “peace and tranquility” idea behind faith. I couldn’t grasp how in this world that God created and, in this person, that God created, he would create so much bouncing off the wall energy, creative energy. Why would he create me with the desire to live a life activity when he seemed so calm, boring, and uneventful. Then, when I was six, my dad took my brother and I skiing in New Mexico for the first time. He was very nervous because I was a wild child, he knew as soon as I hit the slopes I would be ready to go 100 miles per hour... and he was absolutely right. As soon as we got up to the top of a nice easy green, he was explaining the basics and he hadn’t even finished his sentence before I was hightailing straight down the mountain. I ran into the trees and wrecked but loved every second of it. When I got up and looked around at all the snow on top of the trees and all the snow-capped mountain ranges, I knew, I felt God, I saw God, and I loved it! In the extreme situation of going fast down a mountain, I was amped up and found my place in the mountains - I was living “Fully Alive.” I am so excited to use a curriculum created to teach kid’s that God is not boring and that life is meant to be lived “Fully Alive” in Christ.

What a time to “Live Fully Alive!” Eastwood’s Christian Education department and Full Draw Student Ministry are incredibly excited for our VBS that is rapidly approaching! Any child that is entering kindergarten through 5<sup>th</sup> grade will need to fill out a registration form located at the Welcome Center. It costs \$10 per child or \$25 per family (Scholarships available). Snacks, lunch, daily activities and t-shirts are included in the cost of attendance. Starting Aug. 17<sup>th</sup> through Aug. 19<sup>th</sup> from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. children will learn the story of Joseph and his brother, the Life of Paul and Jesus’ walk to Emmaus. “Amped” provides an energetic and interactive way for kids to get excited about their faith in Jesus Christ. Older students who are a part of Full Draw will be leading the event as counselors and get opportunities to step into leadership roles and teach small group lessons! Be sure to sign up if you haven’t already and prepare to get “Amped” for Christ!


